Structure:

- >> Each representative: opportunity to present a specific initiative or policy of their city for the topic in which they participate
- >> Format: a Power Point presentation that must last for a maximum of 20-30 minutes, including the debate and exchanges among the participants of the table
- >> Moderation by representatives from the GO-SUMP project and MedCités: gathering of information and shared knowledge on the specific topics of each table
- >> Panels: they will contain the knowledge collected will be organized with the following information

An event hosted by:

- Name of the project / policy
- Place
- Problem or issue addressed
- Description
- Resources
- Lessons learned

>> Working groups duration: 2 hours where all the projects / policies of the table should have been presented and discussed

>> Plenary session: all shared projects / policies will be presented using the panels by the person responsible for the table panel. It is conceived of as a "dynamic" plenary with questions and interventions from all participants

>> Transfer capacity check: 5 minutes after the end of the session for the participants to complete the 'Transfer capacity check', including the project or policy with the greatest potential for transferability in their city for each one of the topics

>> Final activity: the participants will place *post-it* notes on the panels in those practices that most interest them

>> Final report: the panels and the 'Transfer capacity check' are collected by the facilitator to make a report on the "Peer to Peer" experience.
